Researchers and libraries will notice that we have added quite a few new titles during the past year. Some of them, particularly those which give either exact transcriptions (with indexes) or contain images of original documents, are among the most important advances made in genealogical research in the recent past. Maine and Switzerland are the most obvious beneficiaries of these new titles, but other areas also have benefited.

Once again I would like to call your attention to the availability here of some absolutely wonderful titles published by the Colonial Society of Massachusetts. Some of these titles, and some others in this catalog, are marked "supply low" or similar wording. This isn't a marketing ploy by us (the copies will sell quite soon regardless of whether such a notation is included), just advance notice to you that if you'd like a copy now is the time to buy. Over the past thirty-odd years we have often been able to alert you to these sorts of situations: often we later get anquished inquiries from folks as to where they can get a copy, and in many cases no reprint is likely. I have certainly made the same mistake myself from time to time when buying from other publishers, hope you don't make it yourself.

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This book is the English translation of *Amische. Die Lebensweise der Amischen in Berne, Indiana*, which was first published in the German language in 1988 with a second edition in 2003.

The ancestral way of life of the god-fearing farming folk in the area around Berne, Indiana, keeps alive many of the old customs once practiced in the Canton of Bern in Switzerland.
